Dear sports friends, dear team and club managers,

The results of the 2019 EuroCup events (the Preliminaries and the Finals of EuroLeague 1, 2 and 3 and the Preliminaries, Quarter finals and Final 4 of the Champions League and the Qualification Tournaments 2020) and the new EuroCup Ranking can easily be found on our competitions website ([IWBF Europe Competition](http://www.iwbf-europe.org/competitions)).

To prepare the 2020 EuroCup events, the IWBF Europe Competitions Commission would like to know whether or not your club is interested to participate in one of these events. The Entry Form EuroCup 2020 is enclosed, please return this form after completing to the IWBF Europe Competitions Commission as soon as possible, but in any way not later than 31 August 2019. Returning after this date, participating can no longer be guaranteed.

We ask you to provide us with a club / team email address and no longer with a private one. This email address will be used by IWBF Europe and the LOCs for all communication.

Please note that the Entry Form 2020 must be signed by your NOWB, as approval of your club's participation. Entry forms without signature of your NOWB will not be registered.

The IWBF Europe Competitions Commission also invites clubs to make a bid to organise one of the EuroCup events. All Preliminary Rounds and all EuroLeague Finals can be organised by a team / club which also will compete.

The Quarter Final must be organised by the winner and the runner up of the Final 4 Champions League 2019 and which also will compete.

The Final 4 Champions League can be organised by any club, any organisation, any foundation which wish to organise this event. Only qualified teams from the Quarter Finals can compete.

You can find the Bid-Documents on our competitions website. Please return this Bid-Documents as soon as possible, but in any way not later than 31 July 2019. All organisers will be appointed end of August or shortly after. The allocation of the participants will be published before October 1st.

The Competitions Commission would like to draw your attention to the following points:

1. Dates of the EuroCup events 2020

- a. The Preliminary Rounds of the Champions League will be held from Thursday (dinner) 30 January up to and including Sunday (breakfast) 2 February 2020;
- b. The Quarter Finals of the Champions League and the Preliminary Rounds of EuroLeague 1, 2 and 3 will be held from Thursday (dinner) 12 March up to and including Sunday (breakfast) 15 March 2020;
- c. The Finals of EuroLeague 1, 2 and 3 will be held from Thursday (dinner) 23 April up to and including Sunday (lunch) 26 April 2020;

- d. The Champions League Final 4 will be held from Thursday (dinner) 30 April up to and including Sunday (breakfast) 3 May 2020.
2. Teams may request, through their NOWBs, before September 1st, a Wild Card if circumstances justify it. In this way a team can be placed higher or lower according their official ranking.
3.
 - a. The entry fee for each participating team in a Preliminary Round will be € 1000 for the Champions League, € 900 for the EuroLeague 1, € 850 for the EuroLeague 2 and € 800 for the EuroLeague 3;
 - b. The entry fee for each participating team in a EuroLeague Final will be € 950 for the EuroLeague 1 Final, € 900 for the EuroLeague 2 Final and € 850 for the EuroLeague 3 Final;
 - c. The entry fee for each participating team will be € 1050 for the Quarter Final Champions League and € 1100 for the Final 4 Champions League.
 - d. The goodwill fee for all teams will be € 250;
 - e. Referee fee is from now on included in the Entry Fee.
4. The contribution fee to be paid to the organiser will be € 180 per person for all Preliminary Rounds, € 300 per person for a Quarter Final and the Final Four Champions League and 210 euro per person for the EuroLeague 1, 2 and 3 Final. This fee is for the accommodation and all the meals, for a minimum of 9 and a maximum of 16 persons per team.
5. Clubs, with more than one team, may register up to 24 players of all their teams on the Team Statement. This Team Statement must be signed by an (inter)national licensed Classifier and signed by the NOWB. This Team Statement must be submitted to IWBF Europe before the 1st December 2019. **Changes on the Team Statement after this date are not allowed, are no longer possible and will not be accepted.**

Please do not wire any money to the IWBF Europe Office until you receive the invoice and confirmation of your club's participation.

We hope to welcome your club in one of the 2020 EuroCup events.
